**Carrboro Citizens Invited to 4/21 Forum on
Northern Study Area Plan Review**

The Town of Carrboro has created a Northern Study Area Plan Implementation Review Committee to review the implementation thus far of the facilitated Small Area Plan for the Northern Study Area. The group is also charged with working with town staff to formulate recommendations for the Board of Aldermen regarding how implementation of that plan might be improved and the goals set out in the plan more effectively achieved.

Two public forums have been scheduled where members of the public are invited to meet and share their views with members of this committee. The first forum will focus on the Small Area Plan itself and what has been done to implement this plan since it was approved.

The first forum will be held on Saturday, April 21st in the cafeteria of McDougle School. Registration begins at 7:45am and the program itself runs from 8:15am to noon.

The second forum will be held at the same time of day and location on Saturday, June 16th.

The town has contracted with the Orange County Dispute Settlement Center to help facilitate both forums and other meetings of the committee as needed.
