Reported: 05/15/2012.</p> <p>On 05/15/2012 I responded to 401 NC 54 Apt B39 in reference to a loud party. Earlier in the night, at approximately 231 hrs on 05/14/2012, I had received a loud noise complaint in the "B" building. At the time I was unable to locate the source. The second time I was able to locate the party at apartment B39.</p> <p>The party was extremely loud and I could hear music coming from the sidewalk in front of the building. I made contact with the resident, identified as Priscilla Vaz (W/F 29). Vaz was advised of the Town`s noise ordinance and she agreed to keep the party quiet. She also stated that she was celebrating her graduation. There was a large group of people in the apartment as well as various instruments (guitars, drums, etc).</p> <p>I remained on scene for several minutes after speaking with Vaz. As I was standing downstairs I again heard extremely loud talking coming from her third floor apartment. I spoke with Vaz again and advised her that she needed to end the party as they were unable to keep the volume at a reasonable level.</p> <p>I again waited several minutes and the noise continued. I then issued Vaz a Town Citation (#25465) for the noise ordinance violation. The guests were then asked to leave and I cleared without further incident. LW 1207834	<p>I could still see the truck from where I was situated. Just west of Old Fayetteville Rd the truck traveled left of center and was traveling westbound in the eastbound lane of NC 54. The truck then drifted back to the right and ran off the right shoulder before correcting and returning to the roadway. The truck then drifted left of center again. At this point I activated my lights and siren and attempted to stop the truck. I was just west of Anderson Park when I attempted to stop the vehicle.</p> <p>The truck did not stop and instead increased its speed, still traveling west on NC 54. I contacted Orange County Communications and advised that the vehicle was failing to stop. The truck continued west on NC 54 reaching speeds of 65+mph. I continued to follow behind the truck, witnessing it cross the center line several more times and weaving erratically.</p> <p>The truck slowed and turned south onto Hatch Rd. It appeared as if it was going to stop, then attempted to make a U-turn and return to NC 54. The truck then straightened out and continued southbound on Hatch Rd. The truck continued traveling south on Hatch Rd, at times leaving the roadway and running off both the east and west shoulders of the road. The truck reached speeds of 50+mph on Hatch Rd.</p> <p>The vehicle then lost control and ran off the left side of the road near Harward Ln. It ran over a mailbox and collided with a tree. I advised Orange Communications of the collision and exited my patrol vehicle. As I was approaching the vehicle I witnessed the driver, later identified as James Craven (W/M 57), exiting the truck. I immediately handcuffed Craven and placed him in detention. Craven was unsteady on his feet and had heavily slurred speech. I could also smell a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath.</p> <p>Highway Patrol arrived on scene and began investigating the collision. Trooper Smith took custody of Craven and placed him under arrest for driving while impaired. Craven was then transported to the Chapel Hill Police Department.</p> <p>Bob`s Towing was contacted and arrived on scene to tow the truck.</p> <p>I spoke with Magistrate Maddry in Chapel Hill and acquired warrants against Craven for felony speeding to elude arrest, reckless driving to endanger, and failure to maintain lane control. Magistrate Maddry also found probable cause for Trooper Smith`s DWI charge.</p> <p>While waiting to speak with Magistrate Maddry, Craven fell and advised that he had injured his hip. Orange County EMS was contacted and arrived to evaluate Craven. EMS advised that they would be transporting Craven to UNC ER. He was issued a \$500 unsecured bond for the DWI charge and was not served with my felony warrant. I will serve the warrant at a later date. Craven was then released from custody and transported to UNC.
